The Government of Myanmar has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the Ayeyarwady Integrated River Basin Management (AIRBM) Project, and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contracts for *Refurbishment/Renovation of the 4 regional support centers (in Mandalay, Mawlamyaing, Patheingyi, Myintkyina) and the MHEWC (in Nay Pyi Taw)*.

Ministry of Transport and Communications, Directorate of Water Resources and Improvement of River Systems (DWIR), AIRBM Project, Project Management Unit (PMU) now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the works for *Refurbishment/Renovation of the 4 regional support centers (in Mandalay, Mawlamyaing, Patheingyi, Myintkyina) and the MHEWC (in Nay Pyi Taw)*.

To be considered eligible a contractor must:

- a) Not be under any notice of disbarment issued by the Government, or the World Bank.
- b) Have valid company registration certificate and valid licenses for executing the assignment.

To be considered qualified a contractor must

- c) Have completed within the last 3 years at least two contracts of a similar nature of at least 50% of the value of the bid each.
- d) The proposed works manager must have at least 3 years of experience in works of an equivalent nature and volume and no less than one year as a manager.
- e) Must demonstrate that it will have access to the key Contractor's equipment required for the work.

Bidding will be conducted through the Shopping procedures as specified in the World Bank's [Guidelines: Procurement of Goods, Works and Non-Consulting Services under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants by World Bank Borrowers](#) dated January 2011 (revised July 2014) ("Procurement Guidelines"), and is open to all eligible bidders as defined in the Procurement Guidelines.
